Some students have asked for an experiential rather than an intellectual class that expands individual consciousness. Rather than pursuing the path of licensed practitioner or minister, they were seeking and discovering alternative, authentic ministries. Everyone has a ministry – it is the calling of the soul. People from all walks of life want to live authentically. This day-long retreat series was created to fill this need. It provides an avenue of success that allows the Essential Self to emerge while participants continue with everyday activities. This series benefits anyone who is truly committed to personal unfoldment. It is a progressive series which fosters an unveiling of original innocence and an awakening to the essential SELF. Those who have completed the series continue to step into the stream of life with new confidence as strong expressions of the Essential Self.

## **SOM 350 – Practicum- (7 Once-per-month Sessions)**

The SOM 350 (Practicum) consists of seven monthly meetings after the completion of 300 with a suggested three month break between the two. Books Required: *Return to the One*, Brian Hines; Book of choice on death/dying/grieving.

### **HOURS:**

Total of 21 hours. This course is not given in units. A student may not complete the SOM 100 Series, 200 Series and SOM 300 in less than 3 academic years.

### **STUDENT REQUISITES:**

1. Student must hold certificate for SOM 100 and SOM 200 and 300.

### **TUTION:**

Total tuition is \$250.

### **CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION:**

ICSL Administrative Services will issue a Certificate of Completion upon verification of student's satisfactory completion of 350 and the required 100% attendance of 350. Certificates of Completion must be requested from the ICSL Administrative Services within ninety (90) days of the student's completion of the class, and the form requesting certificates must be received by the ICSL Administrative Services at least thirty (30) days prior to graduation. Churches will be charged \$10 per Certificate of Completion for 350 which is included in the tuition.

## **Classes in the Science of Mind®**

Science of Mind® (also referred to as “Religious Science”) is the core teaching of the International Centers for Spiritual Living. Science of Mind® is a philosophy that integrates spiritual truths with science and physics. Simply put, Science of Mind® teaches the unity of all life. Intentions and ideas flow through a field of consciousness, which actually affects and creates the world around us. This idea is common to most major religions and is supported by the teachings of psychology and quantum physics. In Science of Mind®, we believe that the secret to living a successful life is to consciously choose positive and productive thoughts. Put another way, “As you think, so you become.” It is the intention of the International Centers for Spiritual Living to use Science of Mind® principles as a force for good in our world by transforming personal lives. The Sunday experience at Centers for Spiritual Living is great, and the music and words inspire us. Then we mix and mingle. We meet and greet. We share with like-minded people; congeniality runs high, and we make some new friends, acquaintances, or even business contacts, and it is truly a rewarding and enjoyable time. But, what then? Do you go home to satisfyingly reconnect with those with whom you share domestic bliss? Or do you fortify yourself with the morning’s message and return to the person or issue that you forgot for a couple of hours? Or perhaps you return to the loneliness of wondering, “But, what now?” When you are ready to take it to the next level, you decide to see for yourself what Science of Mind® classes are really all about. What you find is a spiritual gathering place for people who are committed to greater focus and clarity in determining what they really want their lives to be all about. You also find a common purpose and desire to more deeply understand and apply Universal Laws. Those who “stay the course” form an incredible bond, unified by their dedication to apply spiritual principles to the everyday problems of human living. This is a movement from theory to embodiment. As you study the Science of Mind®, you awaken to the dawning of new insights upon your consciousness. Suddenly, the words Life, Principle, Reality, the Law of Mind, Pure Awareness, God and Spiritual Mind Treatment take on a new significance. There is an excitement in working and supporting you and others in using the Science of Mind® and Spirit, to more effectively, promptly, and constructively move through obstacles and ultimately to manifest desired results.

## **Science of Mind™ 300 Series**

The Science of Mind™ 300 Series is designed for the serious student of Religious Science. It is intended to deepen the student's practice and understanding of affirmative prayer and our power to co-create our world. Currently, prerequisites for the 300 series are successful completion of the SOM 100 and 200 courses. SOM 300 consists of 32 weekly classes divided into four terms. The successful student, upon completion of the 300 Series, will have completed the necessary requirements to apply for licensing as a Practitioner of Religious Science. Please note that completing coursework does not automatically guarantee that a license will be issued.

### **HOURS:**

Total of 96 hours. This course is not given in units. A student may not complete the SOM 100 Series, 200 Series and SOM 300 in less than 3 academic years.

### **STUDENT REQUISITES:**

2. Student must hold certificate for SOM 100 and SOM 200.
3. No more than three years may elapse after completion of SOM 100 or 200 and before beginning SOM 300.

### **TUTION:**

Total tuition is \$1,000.

### **CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION:**

ICSL Administrative Services will issue a Certificate of Completion upon verification of student’s satisfactory completion of 300 and the required 90% attendance. Certificates of Completion must be requested from the ICSL Administrative Services within ninety (90) days of the student’s completion of the class, and the form requesting certificates must be received by the ICSL Administrative Services at least thirty (30) days prior to graduation. Churches will be charged \$25 per Certificate of Completion issued for 300 which is included in the tuition.

## **SOM 231: Essential Emma Curtis Hopkins**

Emma Curtis Hopkins' course is designed to move the committed student from "zero to healer" in twelve lessons. *Unveiling Your Hidden Power* includes a "translated" text of her 12 lessons into modern language.

## **Information on SOM 200**

SOM 200 classes consist of a total of 80 hours, comprised of 4 Units of 20 hours each. Units are to be taught in increments of not more than one session per week. SOM 100 and SOM 200 may not be completed by a student in less than two academic years. Selection and sequence of units is at the discretion of the teacher. The tuition for SOM 200 is a minimum of \$440 for the entire course, \$110 per unit, which includes a \$10 recording fee per unit to be sent directly to ICSL Administrative Services. Optional rates are allowed for spouses, review students and high school students. International Centers for Spiritual Living Administrative Services will issue a Certificate of Completion upon the completion of SOM 200. The required attendance is 80%. Certificates of Completion must be requested within ninety (90) days of the student's completion of SOM 200.

## **Why take classes?**

The basic principles we study are profound, but not necessarily easy to embody and practice in our daily lives. Sunday morning is where we hear about our potential, but the classroom is where we experience the practical application of principle. The process of regular Science of Mind® class attendance is how we begin to embody a true change in our consciousness. No matter who you are or what the current issues on your path, in classes you will find a new perspective—in a timeless message that is totally relevant for today. Each class is taught in a fun and fast-paced format. The support of shared insights and the opportunity to ask questions in a classroom setting offer a learning environment not easily duplicated with solitary study. The discipline of regular attendance and the weekly readings create a framework for asking the big questions about life and our place in it.

## **What happens in class?**

Through lectures, discussions, and workshops led by a qualified instructor, the student learns how to personalize the same metaphysical principles which the great masters throughout history have used to experience greater wholeness! Each class takes on an energy of its own which stimulates each individual mind.

## **What will you learn?**

You will learn about your connectedness to an infinite power for good which you can use.

You will learn how to apply Universal Principles in your daily life and get results.

You will learn the art of positive prayer called Spiritual Mind Treatment.

You will learn the value of meditation and daily spiritual disciplines and commitment.

You will learn that you have found new friends and relationships in your classmates who think as you do.

You will learn you really can create a new life by changing your thinking and beliefs.

### **Is there tuition for classes?**

Yes. Taking a Science of Mind® class requires a commitment of both time and money. The truth is little can be achieved without commitment. It creates an expectancy of change which is very valuable. Tuition is set by the International Centers for Spiritual Living and is standard for all Centers. (As of 08/01/2006: SOM 100 and 200 cost \$110.00 for each 8-week course [8 classes of 2.5 hours each]; 300 costs \$1000 for one year plus \$250 for the practicum.

### **What is the value of taking “accredited” classes?**

A certificate of completion is issued at the conclusion of all classes when the attendance and other requirements have been met. After completing a specific number of classes, a student may be eligible to be licensed as a Religious Science Practitioner, and with further class work, as a Minister of Religious Science.

### **SOM 208: Emerson's Essays**

Ralph Waldo Emerson was the most quoted, most inspirational writer in America for over one hundred years. His concepts of the American Voice, of Self-Reliance and of the Oversoul have influenced the New Thought movement profoundly. He is quoted by all the great metaphysical writers and he was the first to break through traditional Christianity in such a way as to inspire multitudes to higher thought. Background information on Emerson's time and his fellow members of the Transcendentalist circle is covered. They include Bronson Alcott, Margaret Fuller, Henry David Thoreau and Walt Whitman. This class is required for first Practitioner licensing.

### **SOM 209: Bible History & Scholarship**

This class examines the history and the many misconceptions of the most published book of all time, with special attention to the fallacies of fundamentalist interpretation. The course looks at the most recent advances in bible scholarship, including the discovery of the Nag Hammadi texts [Gnostic in origin] and the Dead Sea Scrolls. The class is an excellent background course for the New Thought student who wants to know more about the Bible.

### **SOM 226: Shortcut to a Miracle**

This intensive course presents basic Science of Mind principles in the light of modern quantum physics, with special emphasis on the Co-creative Process and Law of Belief, the Law of Expectancy and the Law of Attraction. Students learn how to develop a “miracle-making attitude” and how to use Spiritual Mind Treatment to “make miracles” of their own choosing in Health, Success, Prosperity, and Relationships.

## The Science of Mind® 200 Series

SOM 207, Troward's Edinburgh Lectures and SOM 208, Emerson's Essays, are required for a practitioner license and entry into Science of Mind 400.

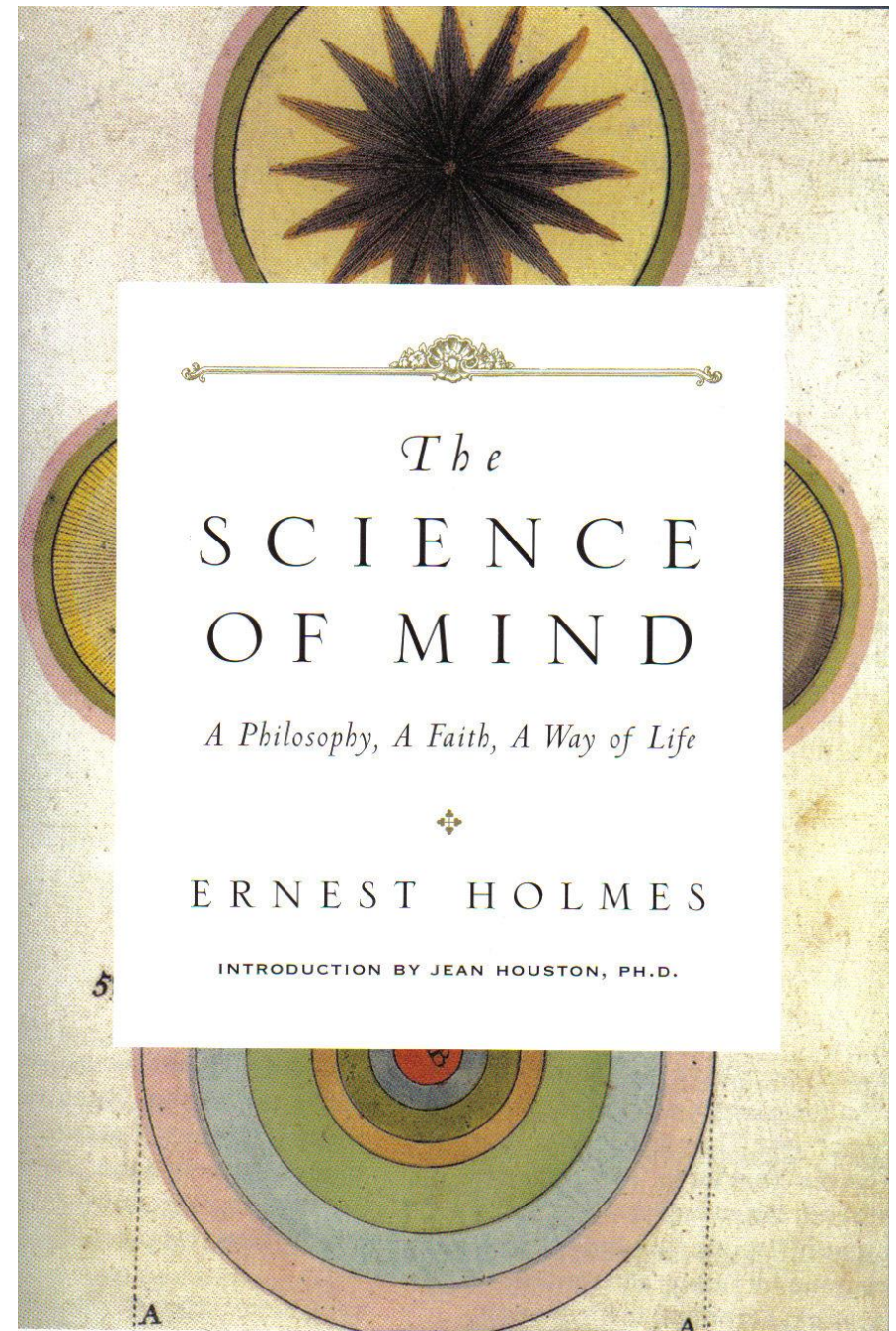

## **The Science of Mind® 100 Series**

The SOM® 100 Series is designed to give the student a solid background in the theory and practice of metaphysical principles. Science of Mind® 100 covers aspects of metaphysical thought, its principles, and practices. Students develop greater self-awareness, understanding of the nature of reality, how life has a spiritual basis, and learns techniques for inner and outer transformation. Four classes, each eight weeks in length, are offered. The dates and times of each class are determined locally, by the ICSL member church. The main text is *The Science of Mind* by Ernest Holmes. SOM® 100 may be taught in any combination of the following options to equal 80 hours. Any four units of 100 approved coursework may be taught to satisfy requirements.

- SOM 101: The Spiritual Path** (20 hours-8 weeks)
- SOM 102: The Nature of Effective Prayer** (20 hours-8 weeks)
- SOM 103: Building a Healing Consciousness** (20 hours-8 weeks)

The Spiritual Path introduces students to the background, history, and beginnings of Science of Mind® as well as to a new concept of God. Classes explore how God relates to the individual and how thought creates our personal reality. This course covers the first 60 pages of *The Science of Mind®*, and introduces the steps of spiritual mind treatment, also known as affirmative prayer.

### **SOM® 102: The Nature of Effective Prayer**

This course covers pages 63-83 in *The Science of Mind®*.

### **SOM® 103: Building a Healing Consciousness**

In *Building a Healing Consciousness*, students deepen their understanding of effective spiritual mind treatment, and develop a greater understanding of the nature of the creative process in the individual. Students will begin building a healing consciousness through their affirmative prayer work. This course covers pages 111-128 and 163-186 in *The Science of Mind®*.

### **SOM® 104: The Principles of Successful Living**

In *The Principles of Successful Living*, students explore the role of consciousness in co-creating his or her life. Upon successful completion, participants will have a greater understanding of their place in this spiritual universe and their relation to the One Creative Source. This course covers pages 266-321 in *The Science of Mind®*.

### **Information on SOM® 100**

Units are to be taught in increments of not more than one lesson per week. Students may not take more than one unit at a time for credit. A student may enroll in the SOM® 100 Series and SOM® 200 Series for credit in any sequence and be awarded certificates accordingly. However, a student may not take SOM® 100 and 200 units simultaneously for credit. The tuition for SOM® 100 is a minimum of \$440 for the entire course or \$110 per unit and includes a \$10 recording fee per unit, which is sent directly to ICSL Administrative Services. However, this class is offered on a donation basis at our Center. ICSL Administrative Services will issue a Certificate of Completion upon the completion of SOM® 100. The required attendance is 80%. Certificates of Completion must be requested from ICSL Administrative Services within ninety (90) days of the student's completion of SOM® 100.
