This privacy policy describes how Centers for Spiritual Living (CSL) uses and protects any information provided by students in the process of registering for, attending, and completing a course offered by CSL in its Education Catalog.

CSL is committed to ensuring that students' privacy is protected. Information provided by students will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

The CSL Education Department collects the following information from each student when registering for a course:

- Full name
- Contact information including postal and email address
- Community affiliation
- Month and Day of birth (inclusion of the year is preferred, but optional)

This information is required for the following reasons:

- Internal record keeping for CSL education administration and for Member Communities where classes are taken.
- The CSL Department of Education may periodically send registered students emails related to courses they have taken or student history to keep our records current.
- The CSL Education Department may, at students' or their community's request, send certificates or correspondence to verify student history.

We are committed to ensuring that all student information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, we have suitable physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect.

We do not make any student information available for solicitation.

EDUCATION PROGRAM

ORGANIZATIONAL VISION: Science of Mind in action, creating a world that works for everyone.

EDUCATION VISION: Centers for Spiritual Living provides education to transform lives and ignite the potential of each individual to connect with their True Self to facilitate personal and global transformation, healing, connection, and purposeful change.

OUR MISSION: To promote living authentically in alignment with Oneness by providing profound, professional, and provocative courses consistent with the Science of Mind philosophy with emphasis on the personal and collective consciousness as embodied and taught by Dr. Ernest Holmes.

PURPOSE AND PHILOSOPHY OF EDUCATION PROGRAM

The purpose of the education program of Centers for Spiritual Living is to provide the resources, structure, awareness, curricula, methods, and tools that support creating a world that works for everyone through the transformative delivery of Centers for Spiritual Living Certificated and Professional Courses.

The philosophy of CSL Education embodies the following tenets:

- Centers for Spiritual Living places great trust in its Ministers to lead, teach, facilitate, and oversee the education programs and Minister/Practitioner teachers within its Member Communities.
- Our work as teachers is ultimately to support our students to transform their lives by the expansion of
 consciousness. Our daily spiritual practice as teachers and the resulting expanded consciousness is
 important to guide the student to grow spiritually. Certificated courses are designed to support the
 teacher to create an open and confidential place for providing tools and techniques for this
 transformation to occur.
- It is a sacred honor to be a spiritual teacher, and with that comes great responsibility to treat students with dignity, honor, respect, and reverence, and to follow the CSL Spiritual Development Education policies and procedures.
- The Spiritual Development Education Department is here to support the work of our Ministers and Practitioners as teachers of Science of Mind courses. The highest role and intent is to facilitate the greatest possible offering of the Science of Mind teaching in the most effective way to students around the world.

ETHICS OF THE SPIRITUAL TEACHER

Why a Section on Ethics?

Ethics is a system of moral principles and rules of conduct or practice, recognized by a particular culture or group.

An ethical act is one where we refrain from causing harm to others' experiences or expectations of happiness. Like a spiritual act, it fosters love, patience, and tolerance. The motivation for ethical acts moves from a consciousness of caring and seeking to benefit others, rather than from self-interest. These acts make for lasting rather than momentary happiness and a sense of well-being.

The Dalai Lama (in *Ethics for the New Millennium*) suggests that those individuals whose conduct is ethically positive are happier and more satisfied than those who disregard ethics. Yet, conducting ourselves ethically means more than merely obeying laws and precepts. It means guarding against those factors which obstruct inner peace and promoting those things conducive to inner peace (i.e., concern for others and a high degree of sensitivity and feeling). A consideration of ethics is an invitation to consider inner motivations and the consequences of one's own actions.

Ethics for Science of Mind Classrooms

As Ministers and Practitioners, we are teachers and facilitators of learning environments for understanding and practicing the Science of Mind teaching. We create teaching and learning environments and experiences in which students who desire to discover and apply this philosophy in their lives may do so. This is accomplished not only through the content of the material studied, but also the experiences they have through what we model for them, and through what is shared by their fellow students.

Our intention is that students experience the following:

- 1. SPIRITUALITY: We model the practice of universal principles expressed by Ernest Holmes in his statement "What We Believe", which is more recently known as the Centers for Spiritual Living Declaration of Principles. That is, we look beyond materiality and invite ourselves and our students into demonstrating an openness to the Unseen, as The Presence is ever seeking to express itself in new ways in our daily lives.
- 2. LOVE: We allow the blessings of Spirit to flow through us and as us so students have an opportunity to discover they are welcome, appreciated, valued, heard, understood, respected, guided, responded to, and validated for the variety of ways which they express.
- 3. INTEGRITY: We honor our spiritual beliefs and are fair in our actions. Students have the opportunity to see consistency between what we say and do. We refrain from any romantic or sexual relationship with our students. Students experience the sacredness of the trust they place in the teacher.
- 4. CARING: We are concerned about, have affection for, and make a conscientious effort to ensure each student has the best learning experience.
- 5. COMPASSION: In all we say and do, we express kindheartedness and generosity toward all. Teachers should be consciously aware of the impact of their words and actions on others'



- wellbeing. This is demonstrated in how assignments are recommended, the way students receive feedback and the nature of dialogue and discussion.
- 6. ACCOUNTABILITY: We are conscientious in fulfilling all course and education program agreements with Centers for Spiritual Living and with the students. We enthusiastically seek opportunities to report to CSL all that is requested, to explain students' responsibilities and to fulfill students' expectations as identified in course descriptions.
- 7. TEAMWORK: We encourage students to learn and work together in harmony. At times students are in positions where they follow, lead, engage in consensus and have the opportunity for individual choices.
- 8. OPEN COMMUNICATION: We create opportunities for teachers and students to express their own thoughts and hear others' authentic thoughts and points of view. Students and teachers discuss, dialogue, and explore meanings behind points of view and feelings expressed.
- 9. CONFIDENTIALITY: Students experience a safe environment where confidentiality around individual sharing is agreed upon by all.
- 10. EDUCATION: We recognize the unique needs of adult learners. Our students have opportunities to reason, discern, acquire knowledge, intuit, contemplate, and prepare to live as spiritually mature and enlightened individuals. They have opportunities to discover, think, talk, observe, and create. They are provided ways to practically apply universal principles and sacred stories to their personal circumstances and to contemporary issues.
- 11. COMMUNITY SERVICE: We create opportunities for students to discover their internal motivations, spontaneous expressions, and spiritual commitment as they anchor their spiritual growth through sacred service in the local and global community.

TEACHING AND LEARNING IN SCIENCE OF MIND CLASSROOMS

Let us begin this section with a quote from our Founder, Ernest Holmes in *The Science of Mind*:

Peace be unto thee, stranger, enter and be not afraid.

I have left the gate open and thou art welcome to my home.

There is room in my house for all.

I have swept the hearth and lighted the fire.

The room is warm and cheerful and you will find comfort and rest within.

The table is laid and the fruits of Life are spread before thee.

The wine is here also, it sparkles in the light.

I have set a chair for you where the sunbeams dance through the shade.

Sit and rest and refresh your soul. Eat of the fruit and drink the wine.

All, all is yours, and you are welcome.

May this be the spirit and vibration in each of our Science of Mind classrooms!

TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES

As teachers of the Science of Mind, you are invited to embrace the "Teaching Order," which embodies the spirit and principles Ernest Holmes' wrote about in The Science of Mind. Your role as teachers is to create a student-centered learning environment that is vibrant, welcoming, spiritually uplifting, inclusive, intellectually stimulating, and practical.

In the Science of Mind classroom, student-centered learning is characterized by the following:

- Supporting Students' Divinity: Recognizing that every student possesses the potential to reveal the
 Divine. Science of Mind teachers acknowledge and build upon the assets, ideas, and unique
 perspectives that each student brings. Learning activities are designed to expand students' spiritual
 repertoire and deepen their spiritual understanding.
- Encouraging Embodiment of Principles: Understanding that true comprehension comes through embodiment. Science of Mind teachers provide experiential learning opportunities. Students are



- actively engaged in using their outer and inner senses to acquire and express new understandings, integrating concepts into their thoughts, feelings, and physical being.
- Motivating Students and Creating Meaning: Drawing on the experiences of adult learners is essential
 to stimulate interest and establish relevance. Science of Mind teachers create opportunities for
 students to connect personal, cultural, historical, and contemporary experiences to the content being
 explored, thus fostering motivation, and finding personal meaning in the teachings.
- Cultivating a Joyful and Orderly Environment: Teachers are encouraged to infuse warmth and joy into
 the learning environment. Students are engaged with the material, connected to the community of
 learners, and encouraged to embrace the spiritual discovery process; both in recognizing their
 limitations and expanding their possibilities.
- Creating a Spiritually Inspiring Atmosphere: Science of Mind teachers set the tone for the course by
 preparing their own consciousness to serve as a conduit of Spirit. Through pre-class activities, teachers
 align themselves with the flow of divine wisdom, intuition, and guidance. Each session begins with a
 centering moment invocation, treatment, meditation and/or visioning experience, and continues
 with thought-provoking questions, intuitive exploration, and creative expressions. The atmosphere
 resonates with awe, wonder, compassion, and devotion.
- Honoring Diversity: Embracing the Global Vision of Centers for Spiritual Living, Science of Mind
 teachers recognize unity of all humanity as a global family. In the classroom, teachers create
 opportunities for students to deepen their sense of connectedness with people of diverse economic,
 age, gender, sexual orientation, ethnic, nationality, religious, and cultural backgrounds. Respecting the
 principle that unity does not imply uniformity, teachers take time to understand and support diverse
 ways of learning, fostering harmony, respect, and fairness among different cultural groups within the
 spiritual community. Language, examples, and application activities honor unique perspectives and
 ways of understanding.
- Providing Intellectual Challenges: Teachers present the curriculum in a way that challenges students' intellectual capacities. Thought-provoking questions stimulating critical thinking, analytical processing, and the ability to summarize key concepts. Students discover themselves informed, mentally stretched, and/or soulfully deepened through engaging assignments.
- Ensuring Practical Outcomes: Science of Mind Teachers draw on the wisdom of master teachers
 throughout history to demonstrate practical applications of subtle and transcendent ways of knowing.
 Sacred stories, the koans, parables, ceremonies, rituals, lectures, discussions, Socratic discourse,
 practical healing demonstrations, and artistic expressions are employed to reveal practical pathways
 for students to transform their lives and transcend limited ways of being. By doing so, students can
 manifest their innate magnificence in the world.
- By embracing these teacher responsibilities, you contribute to the personal transformation of students and the expansion of Science of Mind within Centers for Spiritual Living and beyond. Your dedication to creating an inspiring and inclusive learning experience is deeply appreciated.

SECTION I ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT CERTIFICATED COURSES

Certificated Courses – Centers for Spiritual Living (CSL) uses the term Certificated as follows:

- The purpose of a Certificated Course is to provide individuals with a clear understanding and practical application of Science of Mind principles. These courses, acknowledged by CSL (Centers for Spiritual Living), aim to promote spiritual growth by ensuring that individuals comprehend and are able to integrate these principles into their everyday lives. Furthermore, the hours spent studying in a Certificated Course can be counted towards meeting the prerequisites for enrollment in the Professional Practitioner Training Program at CSL. Certificated courses taken by CSL licensed practitioners can count as CEUs. These courses are open to anyone seeking to enhance their spiritual journey.
- Each education course approved by CSL encompasses essential objectives and concepts that we expect to be conveyed to our students. Our curriculum offers various recommended approaches for delivering these objectives and concepts. While it is crucial to teach the objectives and concepts of a CSL-approved course, our certificated and practitioner education teachers possess the authority to decide which methods to employ, even if they are not explicitly outlined in the existing curriculum. They also have the flexibility to supplement or introduce new material to any established course. Upon completion, students will receive certificates indicating the CSL-Certificated Course name, and their educational transcripts will permanently reflect their course completion.

CSL Courses are not certificated nor accredited by any other agency. Therefore, the courses may not qualify for credit at any other establishment or educational institution.

AUTHORIZED PROFESSIONALS TO TEACH CERTIFICATED COURSES

All certificated courses must be taught and registered through a CSL-affiliated community in good standing or the CSL Online Education Program.

- CENTERS FOR SPIRITUAL LIVING MINISTERS/SPIRITUAL DIRECTORS licensed or ordained are authorized to teach Certificated Courses and the Professional Practitioner Studies Program within a member community of CSL.
- SPIRITUAL PRACTITIONERS licensed by CSL may be authorized to teach Certificated Courses if so approved by the Senior Minister/Spiritual Director of their member community, or their Regional Support Coordinator (RSC), the authorizing individual to sign off on the Registration Form.
- ONLINE COURSE TEACHERS must be licensed as a Practitioner or Minister of a CSL-affiliated Member Community. Practitioners must be approved by their Senior Minister to teach online for an affiliated community. These individuals have demonstrated proven abilities to teach Science of Mind courses and proven online course delivery skills.

AUTHORIZED ORGANIZATIONS TO TEACH CERTIFICATED COURSES

MEMBER COMMUNITIES that are affiliated with CSL may offer Certificated Courses. If the member community is without a Senior Minister/Spiritual Director, Certificated Courses and the Professional Practitioners Studies Program may be offered, if approved and overseen by the Regional Support Coordinator or CSL-approved designee. If your Member Community is without a Senior Minister/Spiritual Director, please contact the CSL Education Department for procedural information by emailing spiritualdevelopment@csl.org. The offering of the Professional Practitioner Studies Program by a Spiritual Practitioner who is the Director of a Teaching Chapter must be approved and overseen by the Sponsoring Minister.

TEACHING CERTIFICATED COURSES AT A MEMBER COMMUNITY WITHOUT A SENIOR MINISTER

If your Member Community is without a Senior Minister, please follow the steps below if you intend to teach certificated courses without a permanent Senior Minister. Questions about this process can be directed to the Spiritual Development Education Administrator at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.

*Please note the process outlined below pertains to Education Department requirements only. There may be additional requirements for your Member Community from other Home Office Departments and/or your Regional Support Coordinator (RSC).

- The Regional Support Coordinator (or Sponsoring Minister for Practitioner-led Teaching Chapters) requests the Approval for Teaching Certificated Education without a Senior Minister form
- The Regional Support Coordinator (or Sponsoring Minister) completes the Approval for Teaching Certificated Education without a Senior Minister form and emails it to spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.
- The completed Approval for Teaching Certificated Education without a Senior Minister form will be kept on file for your Member Community. When your community obtains a new Senior Minister, this form will be marked as inactive.
- Centers without a Senior Minister may have up to three practitioners designated to provide course
 instruction and have access to the necessary curriculum. Approval must be obtained from the
 Education Department at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.
- Certificated course registrations submitted to Home Office while your Member Community is without
 a Senior Minister will be processed as usual, with the verification that only approved instructors are
 teaching certificated courses.
- If your Member Community obtains an Interim Minister, procedures for teaching and registering courses will be addressed on a case-by-case basis. Please contact the Spiritual Development Education Administrator at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org if this occurs.
- When your Member Community fills the position of Senior Minister the above policies will be terminated, and registration and certificate processing will resume normal procedures.



SUGGESTED TUITION FOR CERTIFICATED COURSES

For each course, there is a suggested tuition which CSL Communities can use as a guide for determining what tuition they desire to charge. Centers for Spiritual Living suggests member communities charge the \$45 registration fee plus \$25.00 per course week. For example, a four-week certificated course fee would be \$145 (\$45 registration fee + (4 weeks X \$25/week) = \$145 total tuition charged to student).

CERTIFICATED COURSE REGISTRATION POLICIES

Registration Requirements: All member communities authorized to teach Certificated Courses are responsible for registering all students who pass the course and paying the associated registration fees. Any student who reviews a course to meet time requirements for entry into Professional Practitioner Training or for continuing education for relicensing must also be registered.

<u>All</u> students who pass the course must be registered with the CSL Spiritual Development Education Department within 60 days of course completion whether the student is on track for Practitioner Studies or taking courses for personal interest. Students are encouraged to retain their certificate(s) as proof of course completion and the member community is required to maintain records of the courses each student has completed.

Purpose of Registration Fees: The prompt registration and payment of fees assists CSL in continuing to provide excellent educational support and curricula. The Registration Fee permits CSL affiliated member communities to teach the intellectual property of CSL and supports the development of new curriculum. It also supports the administrative staff, upkeep of the education database, and course development costs.

Class Registration Cost per Student: For US-based communities, effective September 1, 2020, the registration of all certificated courses is \$45.00 per student. The cost to review a course is \$20.00 per student (please review the <u>policies concerning course reviews</u>). For fee information for Global communities, see SECTION III GLOBAL COMMUNITIES INFORMATION.

Time Requirement for Certificated Courses: Certificated courses may count towards Practitioner Training for five years.

Time Requirement for Retired Courses: Courses that are completed, and later retired, still count in the applicable prerequisite category, if the completion date is within the five-year period.

Responsibility for Adhering to Time Requirements: It is the Member Community's responsibility to verify that time limits have been adhered to and that all coursework previously completed is appropriately registered with CSL. The Education Department may also recommend a variance process to senior ministers to keep records accurate and up-to-date.

Variances to these Requirements/Recommendations: The Senior Minister/Spiritual Director of a Member Community may make a request to the Spiritual Development Education Department for a variance to any of these policies.

Certificated Course Recommendation: It is highly recommended that students complete a Foundational level course prior to taking other courses. In addition, it is recommended that students only enroll in one course at a time. This allows for the student to have the opportunity to study the material in depth and apply this new understanding to daily life experiences. A student in any Certificated Course may take another certificated course concurrently with minister's approval. This is conducted at the Member Community level. CSL does not keep track of this in the database.

CERTIFICATED COURSE REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Registration Procedure: The following is an overview of the online registration procedure. If you have questions about registration, please contact the Spiritual Development Education Administrator at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.

- CSL Identification Numbers: Students in the CSL database receive a unique identification number. Member communities use this number to streamline the registration process.
- CSL sends Centers a report of their student's CSL Identification numbers on a regular basis throughout the year. Member communities may add new students to the database, update student contact information, or look up existing student ID numbers when registering classes.

- Member Communities register students within 60 days of course completion member communities and submit the associated registration fees.
- There are two options for submitting certificated registrations online through the registration portal. These options are based on the payment type of either credit card or check. Below are the links based on payment option:
- Check payment registrations: (Checks must be mailed within two weeks of form completion. Certificates are processed when checks are received.) https://csl.tfaforms.net/201.
- CC payment registrations: (Registration and payment occurs in one transaction. Certificates are processed and received within 2-4 weeks.) https://csl.tfaforms.net/113.
- If classes exceed 15 students consistently, please contact spiritualdevelopment@csl.org for an upload option.
- If any of the above registration options do not work for a member community, please contact spiritualdevelopment@csl.org for alternative option for registration.

Online Registration: The CSL ID number is needed to register each student (CSL ID numbers begin with a capital I as in *Igloo* or *ID*entification, not a one).

Courses for Credit: A student receives credit for a certificated course upon meeting the standards of the course. Successful completion of a course is determined by the instructor and properly registered and recorded with CSL. A certificate is issued upon registration.

Course for Review: Students who have successfully completed any Certificated Course that has been registered with Home Office and appears on their record, may retake the same course as a review. The course will be recorded on the student's transcript. The registration fee for a course for review is \$20. A certificate of completion will be issued.

Reviewing a course is for a student who is retaking a course they have already completed, as a refresher. This course must be on the student's record with Home Office. If you have any questions, please contact the Spiritual Development Education Administrator to see if a particular student qualifies for review. A reviewed course appears on the student's transcript.

Tuition for reviewing a course: Each Member Community has the option to set/decrease tuition amounts for courses students are completing as review. Please note that any discount on tuition **does not change the review registration fee of \$20.**

Courses for CEUs: Licensed Spiritual Practitioners may complete certificated courses as CEU credit. These courses are to be registered with Home Office as **Review** and require the \$20 registration fee.

Reprints of Certificates of Completion: Students or Teachers may request a new Certificate of Completion for a previously issued certificate.

Student Progress Reports: Student Progress Reports, a list of completed certificated classes may be requested at any time by the student, minister, or designated Education Administrator. Please email spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.

If you find that a student's Progress Report (student record) is inaccurate, please follow the procedures in the Student Record Issues - Troubleshooting Procedures section.

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT PROFESSIONAL PRACTITIONER TRAINING

Professional Practitioner Training – Centers for Spiritual Living (CSL) uses the term *Professional Practitioner Training* as follows:

- The purpose of Professional Practitioner Training is to train students to go deeper in their Science of Mind spiritual studies (Advanced Consciousness Studies-Year One) with the opportunity to license as a Professional Practitioner with Centers for Spiritual Living (Professional Practitioner Studies-Year Two). These courses, acknowledged by CSL (Centers for Spiritual Living), aim to foster deep spiritual growth in Year One by exploring and integrating these principles into their everyday lives. Year Two explores deeply spiritual support of others, conducting practitioner sessions, and providing spiritual mind treatment for others. Furthermore, the hours spent studying in a Professional Practitioner Training course can be counted towards licensing with CSL. These courses are open to anyone who meets the entry requirements as further explained in this section.
- Our Professional Practitioner Training curriculum offers various recommended approaches for
 delivering these objectives and concepts. While it is crucial to teach the objectives and concepts of
 practitioner education, teachers possess the authority to decide which methods to employ, even if
 they are not explicitly outlined in the existing curriculum. They also have the flexibility to supplement
 or introduce new material to any established course. Upon completion, students will receive
 certificates indicating the CSL-Certificated Course name, and their educational transcripts will
 permanently reflect their course completion.

CSL Professional Practitioner Training Courses are not certificated nor accredited by any other agency. Therefore, the courses may not qualify for credit at any other establishment or educational institution.

AUTHORIZED PROFESSIONALS TO TEACH PROFESSIONAL PRACTITIONER TRAINING COURSES

All Professional Practitioner Training courses must be taught and registered through a CSL-affiliated community in good standing or the CSL Online Education Program.

- CENTERS FOR SPIRITUAL LIVING MINISTERS/SPIRITUAL DIRECTORS licensed or ordained are authorized to teach the Professional Practitioner Training Program within a member community of CSL.
- SPIRITUAL PRACTITIONERS licensed by CSL may be authorized to teach Professional Practitioner
 Training Courses if so approved by the Senior Minister/Spiritual Director of their member community,
 or their Regional Support Coordinator (RSC), the authorizing individual to sign off on the Registration
 Form.
- ONLINE COURSE TEACHERS must be licensed as a Practitioner or Minister of a CSL-affiliated Member Community. Practitioners must be approved by their Senior Minister to teach online for an affiliated community. These individuals have demonstrated proven abilities to teach Science of Mind courses and proven online course delivery skills.



AUTHORIZED ORGANIZATIONS TO TEACH PROFESSIONAL PRACTITIONER TRAINING COURSES

MEMBER COMMUNITIES that are affiliated with CSL may offer Professional Practitioner Training. If the
member community is without a Senior Minister/Spiritual Director, the Professional Practitioner
Training program may be offered, if approved and overseen by the Regional Support Coordinator or
CSL-approved designee. If your Member Community is without a Senior Minister/Spiritual Director,
please contact the CSL Education Department for procedural information by emailing
spiritualdevelopment@csl.org. The offering of the Professional Practitioner Training Program by a
Spiritual Practitioner who is the Director of a Teaching Chapter must be approved and overseen by the
Sponsoring Minister.

TEACHING PROFESSIONAL PRACTITIONER TRAINING COURSES AT A MEMBER COMMUNITY WITHOUT A SENIOR MINISTER

If your Member Community is without a Senior Minister, please follow the steps below if you intend to teach Professional Practitioner Training Courses without a permanent Senior Minister. Questions about this process can be directed to the Spiritual Development Education Administrator at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.

*Please note the process outlined below pertains to Education Department requirements only. There may be additional requirements for your Member Community from other Home Office Departments and/or your Regional Support Coordinator (RSC).

- The Regional Support Coordinator (or Sponsoring Minister for Practitioner-led Teaching Chapters)
 requests the Approval for Teaching Professional Practitioner Training Courses without a Senior
 Minister form from spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.
- The Regional Support Coordinator (or Sponsoring Minister for Practitioner-led Teaching Chapters) completes the Approval for Teaching Professional Practitioner Training courses without a Senior Minister form and emails it to spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.
- The completed Approval for Professional Practitioner Training courses without a Senior Minister form will be kept on file for your Member Community. When your community obtains a new Senior Minister, this form will be marked as inactive.
- Centers without a Senior Minister may have up to three practitioners designated to provide course instruction and have access to the necessary curriculum. Approval must be obtained from the Education Department at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.
- Professional Practitioner Training course registrations submitted to Home Office while your Member Community is without a Senior Minister will be processed as usual, with the verification that only approved instructors are teaching certificated courses.
- If your Member Community obtains an Interim Minister, procedures for teaching and registering courses will be addressed on a case-by-case basis. Please contact the Spiritual Development Education Administrator at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org if this occurs.

 When your Member Community fills the position of Senior Minister the above policies will be terminated and registration and certificate processing will resume normal procedures.

SUGGESTED TUITION FOR PROFESSIONAL PRACTITIONER TRAINING COURSES

For each course, there is a suggested tuition which CSL Communities can use as a guide for determining what tuition they desire to charge. Centers for Spiritual Living suggests member communities charge the \$100 registration fee plus \$25.00 per course week for Advanced Consciousness Studies and \$30 a course week for Professional Practitioner Studies, plus any additional retreat or activity fees (optional).

For example, Advanced Consciousness Studies, a 27-week course with 5-hour workshop, would be priced as follows: \$925 for 27 weeks plus two additional classes scheduled for the online workshop (\$100 registration fee collected upfront + (27 weeks X \$25/week = \$775) + (\$50 for workshop) = \$925 total tuition charged to student). (\$100 of tuition is required to be paid to Home Office. Any tuition outside of the registration fee is monies for the CSL Member Community.)

Professional Practitioner Studies, a 30-module course, would be priced as follows: \$1100 for registration fee, 30 weeks of class, and an end-of-year retreat fee (\$100 registration fee collected upfront + (30 weeks X \$30/week = \$900) + (\$100 end-of-year retreat fee) = \$1100 (\$100 of tuition is required to be paid to Home Office. Any tuition outside of the registration fee is monies for the CSL Member Community.)

Member communities decide how to collect tuition. Registration fees for Professional Practitioner Training courses are submitted to home office August 15th through November 1st. See Professional Practitioner Registration Policies for more information.

PROFESSIONAL PRACTITIONER TRAINING REGISTRATION POLICIES

Registration Requirements: All member communities authorized to teach Professional Practitioner Training are responsible for registering **all** students and pay the associated non-refundable \$100 registration fee per student.

Students who have a Professional Practitioner Training course on their student record may pay a \$20 review fee for a repeat of a Professional Practitioner Training course. The repeat course may be used for continuing education and/or affiliation or reinstatement.

<u>All</u> students must be registered with the CSL Spiritual Development Education Department within the Practitioner Registration Fee Period August 15th through November 1st.

Purpose of the Practitioner Registration Fee: The prompt registration and payment of practitioner registration fees include education verification for Professional Practitioner Training eligibility, signals Centers teaching Professional Practitioner Training for important communication about the Professional Practitioner Training Program and licensing. The Registration Fee also permits affiliated member communities to teach the intellectual property of CSL and supports the development of new curriculum. It also supports the administrative staff, upkeep of the education database, and course development costs.

Practitioner Registration Fee Cost per Student: For US-based communities, effective September 1, 2020, the registration of all Professional Practitioner Training courses is \$100.00. The cost to review a Professional Practitioner Training course is \$20.00 (please review the policies concerning course reviews). For fee information for Global communities, see SECTION III GLOBAL COMMUNITIES INFORMATION.

The Registration Fee for the Advanced Consciousness Studies (Prac I) and Professional Practitioner Studies (Prac II) courses is \$100.00 per student/per year. The fee is non-refundable. The fee includes the cost of registering the student, in addition, a transcript check is completed for all students to ensure Practitioner training prerequisite requirements have been met.

The Advanced Consciousness Studies & Professional Practitioner Studies Education fee is paid by the CSL member community to the Spiritual Development Education Department at the start of the ACS course and the start of the PPS course (August 15-November 1).

CSL Education Department encourages Centers and Teaching Chapters to add the \$100 registration fee to the tuition and educate students that the \$100 registration fee is a nonrefundable fee.

Annually, between the timeframe of August 15-November 1, Centers/Teaching Chapters submit the Practitioner registration and payment directly to the CSL Spiritual Development Education Department by completing an online form for credit card payment https://csl.tfaforms.net/202 (note, payment by check is an option https://csl.tfaforms.net/217).

Late fees of \$75 per class apply to registrations received after November 1st of each year.

- Note - if a student withdraws from a class, the fee may be used for the same student if they re-enroll in Practitioner training within three years for Advanced Consciousness Studies (Prac I), or two years for Professional Practitioner Studies (Prac II).

Entry into Advanced Consciousness Studies

Students must complete six pre-requisite courses as listed in this catalog or meet the following criteria:

Beginning September 2022, students are eligible with minister's approval and variance to enter Advanced Consciousness Studies after completing a minimum of 3 courses of study. One of the three classes must be a Foundational level class, and the other two classes must be from the following list:

- Art and Science of SMT
- Consciousness and the Creative Process
- **Powering Your Decisions**
- Power of Your Word
- Treatment and Meditation
- Visioning: A Way of Life

Note – a student seeking entrance into Professional Practitioner Studies (Year Two) must still meet the six-class prerequisite in the required courses from the subject categories listed in this Catalog, plus must have passed

Advanced Consciousness Studies (see Prerequisite Coursework for Practitioner Studies or Path to Practitioner Studies chart included below). All certificated courses must be completed within the preceding five years of enrolling into Practitioner Studies. If more than five years has elapsed, that course must be retaken. For example, if more than five years has elapsed since taking a Foundational class, a Foundational class must be completed prior to entry into Practitioner Training. No certificated course older than five years will be counted as meeting any requirement for entering Practitioner Studies unless a variance is requested in writing by the Senior Minister/Spiritual Director.

Practitioner Training Entry Application Recommendation: It is recommended that students who are applying to complete Practitioner Training through a Member Community submit a Spiritual Mind Treatment as a part of their application. This allows the instructor/Senior Minister the opportunity to assess the students' Treatment abilities based on the current level of study.

Time Requirement during Practitioner Training: The Advanced Consciousness Studies certificate is valid for three (3) years from the date of course completion for entry into Professional Practitioner Studies. If more than 3 years elapse between the two courses, Advanced Consciousness Studies must be repeated.

Practitioner Licensing: The Professional Practitioner Studies/Practitioner II certificate is valid for two (2) years from the date of course completion for applying for licensure as a Licensed Spiritual Practitioner through Centers for Spiritual Living.

- If more than two (2) years have elapsed since completion of Professional Practitioner Studies, the student must retake Professional Practitioner Studies before reapplying for licensing.
- If more than five (5) years have elapsed since completion of either Advanced Consciousness Studies ... or Professional Practitioner Studies the student must retake a Foundational Course and Advanced Consciousness Studies and/or Professional Practitioner Studies before initiating the licensing process.
- A practitioner license will only be issued with all required courses registered with Centers for Spiritual Living. A completed transcript is required for licensing through Centers for Spiritual Living as a Spiritual Practitioner. Record of courses completed can be requested by email to the Spiritual Development Education Administrator at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.
- The Professional Practitioner Education Exam must be taken and passed prior to licensing (thus taken and passed within two (2) years of completion of Professional Practitioner Studies. Although a student is not required to take the exam in the year they complete Professional Practitioner Studies, it is highly encouraged, as a future exam may be updated/modified; plus, by not taking the exam in the year of completion there will be a natural need to refresh the material. Lastly, the exam must be taken in the annual exam testing window.

Responsibility for Adhering to Time Requirements: It is the Member Community's responsibility to verify that time limits have been adhered to and that all coursework previously completed is appropriately registered with CSL.



Variances to these Requirements/Recommendations: The Senior Minister/Spiritual Director of a Member Community may make a request to the Spiritual Development Education Department for a variance to any of these policies.

PROFESSIONAL PRACTITIONER TRAINING COURSE REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Registration Procedure: The following is an overview of the online registration procedure. If you have questions about registration, please contact the Spiritual Development Education Administrator at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.

- CSL Identification Numbers: Students in the CSL database receive a unique identification number.
- Member communities use this number to streamline the registration process.
- CSL sends Centers a report of their student's CSL Identification numbers on a regular basis throughout the year. Member communities may add new students to the database, update student contact information, or look up existing student ID numbers when registering classes.

- Member communities teaching either Advanced Consciousness Studies or Professional Practitioner Studies register students within the Practitioner Registration Period (August 15th through November 1st).
- There are two options for submitting practitioner student registrations. These options are based on the payment type of either credit card or check. Below are the links based on payment option:
- Check payment registrations: (Checks must be mailed within two weeks of form completion.
 Certificates are processed when checks are received) https://csl.tfaforms.net/217.
- CC payment registrations: (Registration and payment occurs in one transaction. Certificates are processed and received within 2-4 weeks.) https://csl.tfaforms.net/202.

Online Registration: The CSL ID number is needed to register each student (CSL ID numbers begin with a capital I as in *Igloo* or *IDentification*, not a one).

Estimated Course Completion Date: Communities provide an estimated course completion date. This date informs Home Office when to send course completion form to communities.

Estimated Examination Date: Communities provide an estimated date for their final exam. This helps Home Office to schedule exam support for teachers and students.

Professional Practitioner Training Course for Review: Students who have successfully completed any Professional Practitioner Training Course that has been registered with Home Office and appears on their

record, may retake the same course as a review. The course will be recorded on the student's transcript. The registration fee for a course for review is \$20. A certificate of completion will be issued.

Reviewing a course is for a student who is retaking a course they have already completed, as a refresher. This course must be on the student's record with Home Office. If you have any questions, please contact the Spiritual Development Education Administrator to see if a particular student qualifies for review. A reviewed course appears on the student's transcript.

Tuition for reviewing a course: Each Member Community has the option to set/decrease tuition amounts for courses students are completing as review. Please note that any discount on tuition does not change the review registration fee of \$20 due during the Practitioner Registration Period.

Professional Practitioner Training Courses for CEUs: Licensed Spiritual Practitioners may complete certificated courses as CEU credit. These courses are to be registered with Home Office as **Review** and require the \$20 registration fee. CEU equivalency is calculated as follows: Advanced Consciousness Studies 850 CEUs; Professional Practitioner Studies 900 CEUs.

Course Completion Form: Upon final completion of Advanced Consciousness Studies or Professional Practitioner Studies, a Practitioner Course Completion Form must be completed for each student. On the form, you will verify if the student passed the course, and if so, the class completion date. The link to the form is: https://csl.tfaforms.net/244.

Certificates of Completion: Certificates are issued at the end of the course and upon confirmation student has successfully completed the course.

Reprints of Certificates of Completion:

New certificate emailed as a PDF file: No Charge Reprinted and mailed: \$10.00

Student Progress Reports: Student Progress Reports are pulled upon registration and an education verification process is completed on each student. Students and/or Home Office may reach out directly to member communities for course verification and registration to complete a student's education record.

If you find that a student's Progress Report (student record) is inaccurate, please follow the procedures below to get the student's record updated.

Student Record Issues - Troubleshooting Procedures

- 1. **Duplicate records:** In some cases, students may have duplicate records in the system. Please provide any previous names, physical and email addresses, and centers attended for research into this so we may merge any duplicate records and create one record for the student.
- 2. **ICSL classes:** Former ICSL classes taken before 2012 may be located in the old ICSL database. Please provide the name(s) of the courses, Member Community where the course was completed, course completion date and name of instructor. If courses are found in this database, they will be added to the student's record.

3. Classes not on record:

a. For classes before 2012, please have the instructor verify course completion by providing the following information: Name of student, name of course, name of Member Community where



- course was completed, course completion date and instructor's name. Courses will be added to the student record.
- b. For courses completed 2012 to present and not registered with Home Office: Please use the current registration form and procedures and submit payment. Registration details are outlined above.
- c. For courses completed 2012 to present and registered with Home Office and not recorded: Please provide the Education Department with as many details as possible, check number, name of course, course completion date, name of Member Community where course was completed, approximate date registration was submitted. We will conduct further research to update the record.
- 4. **Variance Requests:** Students with only 4 or 5 of the prerequisite courses may be eligible for a variance into Practitioner Training. The Senior Minister can request a variance letter template from the Education Department to be completed, reviewed, and, if approved, saved in the student's permanent record.

SECTION II PATHWAYS TO PROFESSIONAL PRACTITIONER TRAINING

CERTIFICATED SCIENCE OF MIND CURRICULUM PATHWAYS OF FDUCATION

A student may either pursue a certificated course of study in preparation to becoming a Professional Practitioner or Minister in Centers for Spiritual Living (CSL) or take any certificated course for personal growth and understanding. Regardless of the purpose in taking a course, all students who successfully complete a certificated education course must be registered with the CSL Spiritual Development education department.

Beginning in September 2022, the Professional Practitioner Studies Program is offered in two courses, Advanced Consciousness Studies (formerly Prac I) and Professional Practitioner Studies (formerly Prac II). Both courses may be taken either through a Member Community or through the Centers for Spiritual Living Online Education Program.

In order to be eligible for entry into the Professional Practitioner Studies Program (Prac II), the student must have completed and have had registered all required courses, a minimum of 6, as specified in CSL's Policies and Procedures Manual, plus have successfully completed the Advanced Consciousness Course within three years of starting Professional Practitioner Studies. The required courses are summarized on the next page.

At the start of the Advanced Consciousness Studies and also the Professional Practitioner Studies Course: The Practitioner Education Fee (previously called the Course Registration Fee) is now required at the START of the Practitioner course rather than at the completion of the course. This simple change benefits the instructor, the student, the CSL Spiritual Development Education and Licensing and Credentialing Departments, allowing for efficient administration procedures and effective communication.

As of 2021, the Practitioner Education Fee is collected between **August 15 and November 1** each year. The new registration process eliminates the need for a local Center to complete the Practitioner Verification Form and now utilizes the *Online Practitioner Registration Process*. Visit the Education Resources section of the Our Community website for more information.

Note: Centers are required to indicate passing status of each student at the completion of the course.

All Member Communities offering Practitioner Training will be required to submit a list of Advanced Consciousness and/or Professional Practitioner students with an indication if they passed the course or did not pass, and also the class completion date (which is often different than the date input at the time of registration). The list is to be submitted to the Education Program Coordinator at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org.

During the Professional Practitioner Course: At the end of the Professional Practitioner course, students who intend to license as Practitioners with Centers for Spiritual Living are required to complete and pass the Professional Practitioner Education Exam. This exam will test the students' knowledge of all course material from the foundational level through Professional Practitioner Studies/Practitioner II. The annual testing period is April 15th through June 15th.

Students who do not intend to license as Practitioner with Centers for Spiritual Living are not required to complete the exam. Students may elect not to complete the exam but can still receive credit for the



Professional Practitioner Studies/Practitioner II course, should all other course requirements be met. Should a student who previously elected not to complete the exam choose to license in the future, a current passing grade for the exam is required.

Please note that the grade for the Professional Practitioner Exam is valid for one year after completion. After this time the student will be required to retake the exam if applying for licensure as a Practitioner.

Administering the Professional Practitioner Education Exam

It is required that the Professional Practitioner Education exam be proctored. Member Communities may elect to have the instructor of the Professional Practitioner course proctor the exam within the classroom or may elect to administer the exam outside of the classroom with a proctor other than the instructor. Acceptable proctors are those licensed as ministers or practitioner through Centers for Spiritual Living.

Should your Member Community have a student completing the exam with a Disability, all ADA requirements must be met to accommodate this student. Please reference the ADA Testing Accommodations website for more information. CSL can work with any Member Community that may need assistance in providing appropriate accommodations as necessary.

Centers for Spiritual Living Education Department considers 80% a passing grade for the Professional Practitioner Education Exam. If students do not meet the criteria for a passing grade, the following options are available to the instructor for students who do not score an 80% or higher on the Practitioner Education Exam:

Exam Retest

Students who do not pass the exam on the first attempt may retake the exam in an effort to receive a passing grade. The retake must be completed within the available testing window.

Education Requirements

Set appropriate education or relevant requirements for students before moving the student through the Licensing Process. Member Communities may add additional courses to support the student in becoming a successful Practitioner before sponsoring the candidate for licensing. Students will also need to retake the Practitioner Education Exam until a passing grade is met.

Student Specific Options

Practitioner Instructors may contact Rev. Nicole Merges, Director Spiritual Education at nmerges@csl.org, for additional or unique options for students.

Submitting ACS and PPS Grades to Home Office

Once Member Communities have administered the Professional Practitioner Education Exam this information needs to be submitted to Home Office. Please submit exam grades to spiritualdevelopment@csl.org. The Licensing Panel Information form can be submitted to spiritualdevelopment@csl.org. No Practitioner Candidate will be able to License without this information on file.

At time of Practitioner Licensing: Students who complete Practitioner training and are ready to license must have a complete student record (or a signed variance on file stating when any needed requirements will be

completed) and fulfilled all educational requirements for licensing including passing the Professional Practitioner Education Exam within the last 24 months. If there is a question regarding student records, please contact the Spiritual Education Program Manager at spiritualdevelopment@csl.org to check the status of educational records.
